SECTION 208 - PUBLIC ACT 237 OF 2000**

Public Act 237 of 2000, Section 208, requires the Department of Corrections to provide a quarterly cumulative listing of the reports submitted during the previous quarter, as well as the reports expected to be transmitted in the following quarter.
