SUBJECT: State of Michigan 1122 Program

State and local law enforcement agencies whose missions are to support counter-drug, emergency response, and homeland security activities may purchase equipment through specific federal sources. The 1122 program affords state and local governments the opportunity to take advantage of discounts available to the federal government commensurate with large volume purchases.

The Governor has designated the Department of Technology, Management and Budget, Purchasing Office, as the State Point of Contact (SPOC) for the 1122 Program. The SPOC facilitates the purchase of the equipment and supplies for eligible agencies.

To be considered eligible, interested agencies must complete and return the enclosed "Application for Participation" and the "Law Enforcement Agency Data Sheet". Once received, the SPOC will determine agency eligibility for access to equipment under the program. The SPOC will notify the requesting agency in writing when the request is approved. This notification will include the "Procurement Request Forms" to be used when ordering equipment and supplies.
