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## **Saturday vehicle auction to include flex fuel vehicles and Secretary of State services**

More than 230 vehicles and pieces of equipment, including approximately 50 flex fuel vehicles; will be offered at the Department of Management and Budget vehicle auction, which begins at 10 a.m. Saturday, July 15, at 721 Canal, Lansing.

Prospective buyers may examine vehicles from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Friday and from 8 to 9:30 a.m. Saturday.

The auction bid list includes passenger cars, sport utility vehicles, trucks, vans, buses and dump trucks. Flex fuel vehicle models include the Dodge Caravan, Ford Taurus, and Chevrolet Impala and Silverado, which operate on E85. This alternative fuel is a blend of 15 percent unleaded gasoline and 85 percent ethanol, a renewable energy source produced from corn or other grains.

For the first time, buyers will be able to transfer the title on the spot using the Secretary of State's mobile branch office, which will be parked at the site. Visitors to the office-on-wheels may obtain a variety of services such as obtaining licenses and personal identification cards, registering watercraft and snowmobiles, and registering to vote.

Equipment such as a mower, loader, reach-all tower and flatbed trailer will also be auctioned. The bid list can be viewed at [www.michigan.gov/doingbusiness](http://www.michigan.gov/doingbusiness). Select "Buying from the State" and "State Surplus Auction" at the left of the Web pages.

Bidders must attend the auction, and payment is expected at the time of purchase. Cash, MasterCard, Visa, Discover, American Express or checks made payable to the State of Michigan will be accepted. Buyers must remove purchases within three working days.
