ARSON FOLLOW-UP SCHOOL

ARSON FOLLOW-UP SCHOOL is presented by the Michigan State Police, Special Investigation Division for police and public safety officers only. This program is NOT designed to instruct fire origin and cause determination, but to provide the follow-up investigator with the necessary skills to continue the investigation once a qualified fire expert has determined that the fire was arson. Various methods of instruction will be utilized to facilitate learning, including a hands-on, role playing scenario. Classes include:
