If actual sales tax revenues are different than projected, or the Legislature makes changes to the budget, the distributions will be adjusted.

2) A local unit may conduct a special census not less than three years from the enumeration date of a regular statewide federal decennial census. Special census payments are supplemental payments in addition to the normal revenue sharing payments. The legislature must pass an additional appropriation for these payments. The legislature did not appropriate funding for special census payments in FY 2007 through FY 2010. For FY 2011 and 2012 the decennial federal census was used, and per the revenue sharing act, special census counts cannot occur until 2013.
