The State of Michigan will pay **\$54** per Advanced Placement (AP) Exam for public and private school students qualifying for the College Board fee reduction.

**Final AP Exam fee for qualifying students: \$0**

**What the school must do:**

- Fill in the "Option 1" oval on qualifying students' AP Exam answer sheets.
- In the Remittance section of the AP Shipping & Remittance form, enter the total number of exams (not students) that qualify for the fee reduction.
- AP Coordinators in Michigan will forego collection of AP Exam fees from students qualifying for the College Board fee reduction. The College Board will bill the State directly for qualifying students' AP Exam fees.
