The MUCP makes decisions on behalf of all businesses in the state of Michigan that want to be certified DBEs and represents all USDOT funded agencies with DBE programs. In other words, firms certified as DBE's with the MUCP are eligible to work on any federally-funded airport, highway or transit contract, as a DBE.




Breakdown of 2005 Dollars




DBE Dollars Earned (2005 FHWA Dollars Only)

2005 DBE Participation




