2. MILK HOUSE PLANS – REQUIRED	CONSTRUCTION/INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

3. BULK TANKS – PLANS REQUIRED	
<input type="checkbox"/> New or used tanks	Sufficient capacity to cool milk to 45°F within four hours of start of milking and within two hours after end of milking. (See formula for BTU calculation in installer's manual)
4. MILKING STABLES/PARLORS – PLANS REQUIRED	Grade A plans shall address all requirements of the Pasteurized Milk Ordinance (PMO). (See checklist in installer's manual)

5. FREE STALLS – PLANS <u>NOT</u> REQUIRED	
6. MANURE HANDLING SYSTEMS AND STORAGE- <u>PLANS</u> NOT REQUIRED	Must meet Michigan 75-foot isolation requirement
