Glossary

- Both Subjects** English language arts (ELA) and mathematics - a school district must make AYP in both subjects to make AYP at a grade range.
- ELA** English language arts - MEAP assessment that includes measures of both reading and writing.
- Graduation Rate** Michigan requires a graduation rate at or above 80% to make AYP at the high school grade range.
- Participation** To make AYP, the district must have at least 95% of its enrolled students participate in state assessment in both English language arts and in mathematics.
- Subgroup** School districts must make AYP for the district as a whole and for each student group of 30 or more students. The student groups measured for AYP are racial/ethnic groups (American Indian, Asian American, Hispanic, White, and Multiracial) students with disabilities, limited English proficient, and economically disadvantaged students.
- Whole School** The assessment scores of all students are counted for the "whole school" determination of AYP.
