Glossary

Both Subjects English language arts (ELA) and mathematics - a school district must make AYP in both subjects to make AYP at a grade range.

ELA English language arts - MEAP assessment that includes measures of both reading and writing.

Graduation Rate Michigan requires a graduation rate at or above 80% to make AYP at the high school grade range.

Participation To make AYP, the district must have at least 95% of its enrolled students participate in state assessment in both English language arts and in mathematics.

Subgroup School districts must make AYP for the district as a whole and for each student group of 30 or more students. The student groups measured for AYP are racial/ethnic groups (American Indian, Asian American, Hispanic, White, and Multiracial) students with disabilities, limited English proficient, and economically disadvantaged students.

Whole School The assessment scores of all students are counted for the "whole school" determination of AYP.
