

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

Fennville Public Schools are seeking qualified contractors to remove asbestos containing material from the High School and Middle School. A mandatory pre-bid meeting will begin at 2:00 p.m., 4 April 2005, which will convene at the High School cafeteria. Contact Villa Environmental Consultants, Inc., with questions regarding the scope of work. Each contractor will be given ample time to view the work areas and to verify existing conditions.

Sealed bids, labeled Spring and Summer 2005 Asbestos Removal, will be received until 2:30 p.m., local time, 13 April 2005 at the administration offices of Fennville Public Schools, 5 Memorial Drive, Fennville, MI. The bids will be opened and publically read aloud at 3:00 p.m. at the cafeteria. The board of Education will not accept or consider any bids received after the deadline.

Bid security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Bid must accompany each Bid in accordance with the instructions to Bidders. The successful Bidders will be required to furnish Performance and Payment Bonds for one hundred percent (100 %) of their Contract amount prior to execution of Contracts.

A responsive Bid must also be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement from the Bidder, disclosing any familial relationship between the owner or an employee of the Bidder and any member of the district's Board or the Superintendent of the district. The board cannot accept a Bid that does not contain a sworn and notarized disclosure statement.

The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid and to waive any irregularities in bidding, consistent with law, which best serves the interests of Fennville Public Schools. All bids may be held for a period not to exceed 90 days before awarding a contract.
