SCOPE OF WORK includes all work to provide, install and coordinate the installation of furnishings for the New Middle School

**BIDS:** Sealed bids for the Contract will be received at the **Flushing Community Schools Administration Building, 522 N. Mc.Kinley Road, Flushing, MI 48433 until Wednesday October 19<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 pm local time**

**BID SECURITY:** Bid security in the amount of 5% of the bid amount including alternates must accompany each.

Each general bidder may obtain up to two sets, and each sub-bidder may obtain one set. Additional sets may be purchased for \$50.00 per set (non-refundable). Bidders requesting mailing or delivery shall pay cost for shipping and handling of \$15.00 per set.

**BONDS:** The successful General Bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond and a labor and materials payment bond, each in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price, and of a surety company qualified to do business under the laws of the Commonwealth.

All bids shall be accompanied by a sworn statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the Owner(s) or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board of Education of the School District or the Superintendent of the School District. The Board of Education shall not accept a bid that does not include a sworn and notarized familial relationship disclosure statement.

The Awarding Authority reserves the right to waive irregularities and to reject any or all bids if it is in the public interest to do so, and to reject any bid if the Awarding Authority determines that such bid does not represent the bid of a person competent to perform the work as specified or if fewer than three bids are received. The preceding sentence shall not be construed to limit the Awarding Authority's rights to accept or reject general bids and bids in accordance with Michigan Law.
