The Board of Education of Fraser Public Schools is accepting firm, sealed bids for all labor, materials, equipment and all other services to complete Asbestos Abatement at Fraser High School for Fraser Public Schools.

Specifications and proposal forms can be obtained at the mandatory walkthrough.. A **mandatory** pre-bid walk through is scheduled for April 26, 2005 at 3:00 p.m. Meet at Fraser High School Main Lobby.

Your proposal marked "Asbestos Abatement for Fraser High School" will be accepted during regular business hours (8:00 a.m. to noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.) at **33466 GARFIELD RD. FRASER, MICHIGAN 48026**, but must be **HAND DELIVERED OR DELIVERED BY COURIER NO LATER THAN 1:00 PM MAY 4, 2005. BID PROPOSALS RECEIVED AFTER THIS TIME WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED OR ACCEPTED. IF MAILING YOUR PROPOSAL VIA THE POST OFFICE, SEND TO THE SAME ADDRESS.** Oral, telephone, fax, or electronic mail bids are invalid and will not receive consideration.

All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately thereafter at the Board Office.

All contracts to be entered into by the Fraser Public Schools must and will comply with the minimum wage and equal opportunity laws of the State of Michigan.

No bids may be withdrawn for at least 180 days after the bids are opened. All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid packet.

All bidders must provide familial disclosure in compliance with MCL 380.1267 and attach this information to the bid proposal. The bid proposal will be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Fraser Public Schools School Board, or the Fraser Public Schools Superintendent. The District will not accept a bid proposal that does not include this sworn and notarized disclosure statement.

Proposals must include a bid bond or certified check made payable to Fraser Public Schools for not less than 5% of the contract and must be submitted on the bid proposal form furnished with the specifications. All proposals will remain firm for a period of 180 days.

The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, either in whole or in part, to award contract to other than the low bidder; to waive any irregularities and/or informalities; and in general to make awards in any manner deemed to be in the best interests of the owner.
