Each proposal must be accompanied by a satisfactory certified check, money order or bid bond payable to the Fremont Public Schools for not less than five (5%) percent of the amount of the bid and delivered in a sealed envelope bearing the bidder's name, address and project identification.

Applicable Michigan use and sales tax apply to this project. This project does not require prevailing wages.

Project Summary: Replace existing Middle School's wood stage floor with new concrete slab on metal decking. Work includes miscellaneous demolition and new construction as outlined on the construction documents.
