Reconditioning of Track Surface

The reconditioning project consists of the following:

1. Clean surface of loose or foreign materials.
 2. Apply a latex tack coat
 3. Repair all worn areas.
 4. Apply two (2) coats of stranded rubber and latex to all areas.
 5. Apply a final sheen coat to all areas
 6. Paint new lane lines and event markings according to the National Federation of State High School Association.
 7. Project is to include one (1) crossover tarp.

For bids \$18,915 or more, a minimum of 5% bid security, either in the form of a Bid Bond or Cashiers' Check payable to Gerrish-Higgins School District, must accompany each bid. The Performance and Payment Bonds shall be in an amount equal to the contract amount. The Performance and Payment Bonds shall be solely for the protection of Gerrish-Higgins School District and must be executed by a surety company

authorized to do business in the State of Michigan. Bidders shall agree not to withdraw proposals for a period of sixty (60) days after date for receipt of bids.

All proposals must be submitted no later than 2:00 p.m. on July 17, 2006. The Board will not consider or accept a bid received by the Board after this date and time. All proposals should be delivered in a sealed envelope and addressed to Gerrish-Higgins School District and be clearly marked: Bid for Reconditioning Existing Running Track Surface.

The bid shall be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exist between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board or the Superintendent of the Gerrish-Higgins School District.
