



# How to Identify Flexible Fuel Vehicles

Flexible Fuel Vehicles can run on unleaded gasoline, E85 or any mixture in between. E85 is a blend of 85% ethanol and 15% gasoline. Ethanol is a renewable, high-octane, low-emission fuel produced from corn or other grains.

**E85-capable vehicles can be identified by the wording E85 or ethanol inside the vehicle's fuel cap door.**

Some Flexible Fuel Vehicles have an emblem on the fender that identifies them as E85 compatible:

The 8<sup>th</sup> character of the vehicle VIN (vehicle identification number) indicates that a vehicle is E85 compatible.
