We'll explore some of the trails around the park and see what birds we can find!



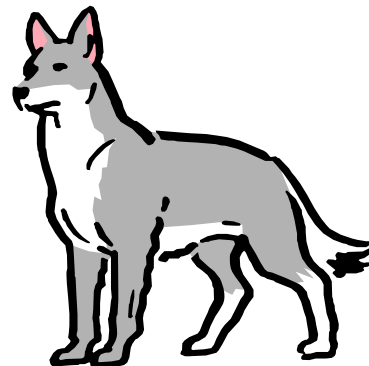
