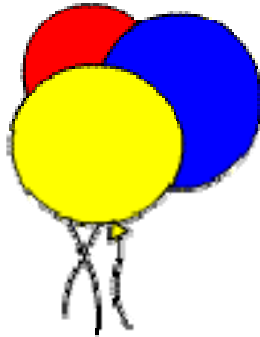

Who lives in Baraga State Park? Join us on an adventure hike that will show you how many residents we have!

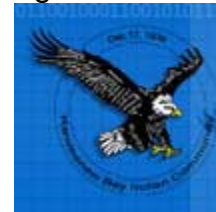


**Friday Night Highlight!**
