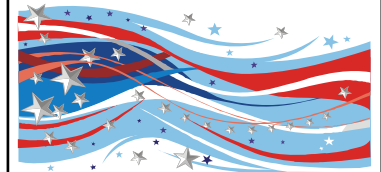
MAYBURY TRIVIA:

Meet at the Concession Building Area.

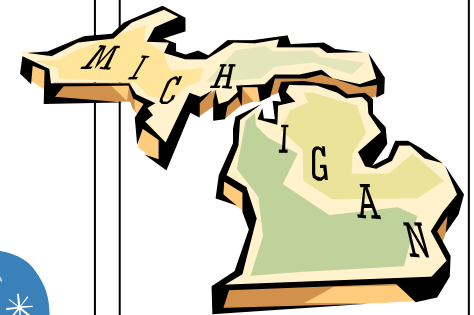


SATURDAY
