



MDCH Outpatient Prospective Payment System (OPPS) Seminar Announcement

The Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) is pleased to offer an OPPS seminar for providers impacted by the April 1, 2007 implementation of its OPPS reimbursement methodology. The seminar will focus on a broad over view of OPPS as well as Medicaid's transition to this reimbursement methodology. Providers with no experience billing services under the Medicare OPPS will particularly benefit from the seminar.
