- A. Lakeshore Public Schools is seeking offers under seal for new unit ventilators to Lakeshore High School located at 5771 Cleveland Avenue, Stevensville, Michigan 49127. Address sealed bids to Mr. Rob Burgess, Business Manager. All bids will be received until 2:00 P.M. (Michigan Local Time), February 10, 2006, at Lakeshore Public School Offices located at 5771 Cleveland Avenue, Stevensville. The offers will be opened and read publicly in the adjacent Board Room starting at 2:00 P.M. (local time) on February 10, 2006. Late bids cannot be accepted. All bidders shall bid in accordance with and upon the Bid Form included in the Contract Documents. Submit two copies of Bid Proposal.
- B. Project Description: The project consists of equipment purchase contract for unit ventilators, cabinet heaters, fan coil air conditioning, and fin tube radiation units, and hydronic unit heaters only. All equipment will be installed at Lakeshore High School under separate contract.
