Your firm is invited to submit an offer under seal to Lakeshore Public Schools for walk-in cooler and freezer replacement at the Middle School located at 1459 West John Beers Road, Stevensville, Michigan 49127 before 3:00 p.m. local time on the 15th day of March, 2005. Bids are to be hand-delivered to the Central Business Office at the High School - Address Bids to Lakeshore Public Schools, 5771 South Cleveland Avenue, Stevensville, Michigan 49127. Bids will be opened and read publicly at that time. Late Bids will not be accepted.

Project Description: Under the Base Bid this work shall consist of minor wall and floor demolition and demolition of existing walk-in cooler and freezer in kitchen and replacing with new larger, walk-in cooler and freezer, totaling approximately 230 s.f. Construction will begin on May 27, 2005 and Date of Substantial Completion is June 20, 2005.
