

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
CONNECTOR ADDITIONS
LIVONIA PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

The Livonia Public Schools Board of Education will receive firm prime contractors bids for the proposed Connector Additions located at Frost Middle School, 14041 Stark Road, Livonia, Michigan. The work will consist of installing two new connecting corridor enclosures and associated work along the south side of Frost Middle School.

The bidding documents consist of plans and specifications. Documents may be obtained by depositing **\$25.00 (non-refundable)** payable to Livonia Public Schools, at the Livonia Public Schools, Purchasing Department, 15125 Farmington Road, Livonia, Michigan 48154, attention Ms. Lissa Wilk (734) 744-2511.

The envelope bearing your proposal must identify the proposal being bid and addressed to the attention of Ms. Lissa Wilk, Purchasing Supervisor. It shall be delivered to the Livonia Public Schools, 15125 Farmington Road, Livonia, Michigan 48154. Each proposal must be submitted on the forms furnished in this document and must be completed in full. Each proposal shall be identified and sealed in an opaque envelope and marked with the name of the bidder and the proposal(s) being bid. A bid bond executed by a Treasury listed surety company acceptable to the Livonia Public Schools, or a cashier's check in the amount of at least 5% of the sum of the proposal payable to Livonia Public Schools shall be submitted with each proposal over \$18,344.00.

All proposals shall be firm for a period of sixty (60) days.

Bids will be publicly opened and read at a meeting convened at the Livonia Public Schools Office starting at 11:00 A.M., May 17, 2005.

Successful bidders whose proposals are \$50,000.00 or more will be required to furnish a Treasury listed Performance Bond and Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of their bid. The cost of the bond shall be included in each proposal.

The Board of Education reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids in whole or in part and to waive any informality therein. Livonia Public School District reserves the right to accept that bid which in its opinion, is in the best interest of the owner.
