What is a Buyers Mission?

A Buyers Mission invites prescreened international buyers to the U.S. who want to import American food products. Appointments are made for you to meet with these buyers one-on-one to sell your products. Before registering for the mission, U.S. exporters receive a list of buyers and their products of interest to determine which buyers they would like to meet.

One day with international buyers from 11 countries

Buyers from Korea, Southeast Asia, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Brazil and Canada who are in the retail and wholesale industries will be visiting three cities in the Midwest. They are interested in purchasing products such as:

- bakery items
- variety of snack foods
- beef, seafood and poultry
- salsas and sauces
- beverages
- and more!

For more than three years MIATCO and Food Export USA have sponsored the Northeast Buyers Mission, which last year produced these results:

- 37 out of 85 participating exporters made their first export sale
