



RE: APPROPRIATIONS – Report of time spent providing legal services under various  
categories; Fiscal Year 2000-2001

I have attached documentation to show how the Transportation Division of the Department of Attorney General calculated the amount of time its attorneys spent providing legal services under each of the categories specified in §334 of 2000 PA 271. I am reporting that time by percentage of total legal services provided by the Division, for each of the categories, as follows:

<u>General</u>	<u>State Trunk Line</u>	<u>Local Projects</u>	<u>UPTRAN</u>	<u>Aeronautics</u>
16.75%	66.25%	7.25%	6.5%	3.25%

That was calculated by adding the total number of hours spent in all five categories by all attorneys in the Division, then dividing figure that into the amount of time spent by all attorneys in the Division in each category.

I was not aware that a similar report was needed for FY 02. I will ask the attorneys to keep time records for selected portions of what remains of FY 02 to ascertain whether there has been any significant change in the allocation of our time.
