For control of powdery mildew (caused by *Erysiphe graminis* f.sp. *tritici*). Tilt will also control leaf and glume blotch diseases (*Septoria tritici* and *Stagonospora nodorum*), leaf rust (*Puccinia recondita*), and provide suppression of Fusarium head blight (*Fusarium* spp.) in wheat.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.

Wheat

In wheat, Tilt controls powdery mildew (caused by *Erysiphe graminis* f.sp. *tritici*). Tilt will also control leaf and glume blotch (*Septoria tritici* and *Stagonospora nodorum*) and leaf rust (*Puccinia recondita*). Apply 4 fl. oz. of Tilt per acre by ground or aerial application.

For suppression (ca. 50% control) of Fusarium head blight (*Fusarium* spp.), apply 4 fl. oz. of Tilt per acre by ground or aerial application at Feekes Growth Stage 10.5.

Tilt can be applied through Feekes Growth Stage 10.5 (full head emergence). **Do not** apply after this growth stage to avoid possible illegal residues. **Do not** apply within 40 days of harvest. Tilt may be applied earlier if disease symptoms appear.

Notes: To avoid possible illegal residues: (1) **DO NOT** apply more than 4 fl. oz. of Tilt per acre per season. (2) **DO NOT** apply within 40 days of harvest. (3) **DO NOT** graze or feed livestock treated wheat, straw, forage, or hay. (4) **DO NOT** cut the green crop for hay or silage. (5) After harvest, the straw may be used for bedding.
