

Maternal Infant Health Program Design Structure and Process

Three groups are participating in the MIHP design process, as described below:

MIHP Steering Committee

This group of 15 persons consists of state agency personnel and project consultants. It is responsible for the nuts-and-bolts work of designing and implementing the new program. It will meet as often as necessary between monthly meetings of the MIHP Design Workgroup.

MIHP Design Workgroup

This group consists of the MIHP Steering Committee members plus representatives of 18 key stakeholder groups. It is charged with providing input on the design and implementation of the new program.

Large Stakeholder Group

This group consists of an unlimited number of persons who wish to receive periodic updates about the work of the MIHP Design Workgroup and Steering Committee. Updates may be provided via email, web site, special meetings, etc. Members will be encouraged to provide input on drafts of various products.
