



Points will be assessed as if violation written under Michigan Vehicle Code or substantially corresponding local ordinance. Points will affect original CDL application eligibility.

These crimes do not count as priors for any enhancement for suspensions, revocations, plate confiscation, immobilization, or registration denial.

No Court ordered vehicle immobilization.

SOS Code 1000 and "OR" Vehicle Type = On-Road offenses (points)

SOS Code 8000 and "OR" Vehicle Type = Off-Road offenses (points)

SOS Code 1000 and "SM" Vehicle Type = On-Road offenses (points)

SOS Code 8000 and "SM" Vehicle Type = Off-Road offenses (points)

Attempts are treated as though completed.

Cases not included in judges' audit.

Two new errors:

INV VTYPE-NEED OR = No OR in the vehicle type for a crime committed on an off-road vehicle. THIS IS USED WHEN ARRESTING FOR ALCOHOL IN AN ORV OFF THE ROAD WITH OFFENSE CODE 8000.

XXXX-VIOL<10/01/2000 = Offense committed prior to 10/01/2000.

The ORV-Knowingly Allowed **324.80034(3)** crime is not counted as a prior offense for purposes of criminal/licensing sanctions enhancements. This crime is a Misdemeanor offense that carries up to 93 days jail or fine not less than \$100 or more than \$500 or both.

Section 81134(12) requires that each municipal judge and clerk of the court shall prepare and immediately forward an abstract of conviction for a violation of this section which includes the felonies and knowingly crime.

Section 320a requires that points to be given for certain crimes committed in an ORV or Snowmobile. These crimes include:

The Snowmobile-Knowingly Allowed **324.82127(2)** crime is not counted as a prior offense for purposes of criminal/licensing sanctions enhancements. This crime is a Misdemeanor offense that carries up to 93 days jail or fine not less than \$100 or more than \$500 or both.

Section 732 requires the clerk of the court to prepare and forward to the Secretary of State an abstract of conviction for the above-listed offenses. *The law requires 6 points for a felony committed in an ORV or Snowmobile, these include the Death or Injury crimes and the abstracting requirement is listed in a separate section.

Section 82141(3) requires that each municipal judge and clerk of the court shall prepare and immediately forward an abstract of conviction for only the Snowmobile-OUIL/OUID, UBAC and OWI crimes.
