Subject: Health Care Eligibility Policy Manual

Effective: July 1, 2006

Programs Affected: Medicaid, Adult Benefits Wavier, MOMS, Family Planning Program (Plan First!)

On July 1, 2006, the Health Care Eligibility Policy (HCEP) Manual will be eliminated. Beginning on this date, all official Medicaid, Adult Benefits Waiver (also known as Adult Medical Program), MOMS, Family Planning Program (Plan First!), and TMA-Plus plus eligibility policy will be included in the Department of Human Services Program Eligibility Manual (PEM), Program Administrative Manual (PAM), and Program Reference Tables (PRT) manual. These items have been and will continue to be jointly developed by the Department of Community Health as the Medicaid single state agency and the Department of Human Services as the entity responsible for the administration of the Medicaid eligibility determination process.
