**Subject:** Termination of Sexual or Erectile Dysfunction Drug Coverage

**Effective:** February 1, 2006

**Programs Affected:** Medicaid, Children's Special Health Care Services, Adult Benefits Waiver

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform providers of the change in coverage of sexual or erectile dysfunction drugs for beneficiaries.

Due to the passage of the Qualified Individual (QI), Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA), and Abstinence Programs Extension and Hurricane Katrina Unemployment Relief Act of 2005 (Public Law 109-91), Medicaid funding is no longer available to cover sexual or erectile dysfunction drugs dispensed. This change will be effective for dates of service on or after February 1, 2006.

### Manual Maintenance

This bulletin should be retained until the information is incorporated into the Michigan Medicaid Provider Manual.
