- I. WELCOME Commission Chairperson Kimberlydawn Wisdom called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.
- II. WORKING SESSION Commissioners discussed each section of their draft report, making suggestions for changes in substance and framing of key issues. MDCH staff added clarification and answered questions.
- III. NEXT STEPS Staff will incorporate the changes recommended by Commissioners and circulate an updated draft for further review and comment. Staff and Chairperson Wisdom will review the draft with MDCH Director Olszewski.
- IV. OTHER BUSINESS Commissioners reviewed two specific requests made by the Leadsafe Partnership in its testimony of October 24. The Partnership requests the Commission to “endorse in concept” legislation of a 10-year lead hazard reduction law, and legislation to require lead risk assessment of commercial and industrial facilities to residential use. Commissioners agreed they needed additional information in both cases in order to identify a position on either matter. Commissioner Dyer will obtain and circulate draft language regarding a 10-year hazard reduction law. Commissioner Sills will compile existing construction standards regarding soil assessment, demolition, and construction lead so that the Commission can assess the need for additional regulation of the conversion of non-residential property to residential use.

- IV. PUBLIC COMMENT Dr. Wisdom opened the floor to public comment, and there was none.
- VII. ADJOURN Dr. Wisdom adjourned the meeting at 5:00 p.m.
