Non-Competitive Bid Contract Document

We have recently revised the Construction by Non-Competitive Bid Contract document to allow a small portion of the work to be subcontracted at the request of several agencies and with concurrence from the Federal Highway Administration. The new guidelines allow up to 10% to be assigned to a subcontractor, but this amount would not be reimbursable. Therefore, the maximum amount eligible for reimbursement would be \$94,000 (6% required savings from \$100,000) minus the subcontracted amount (100% local cost). This subtotal would be multiplied by the federal participation ratio (usually 80%) to determine the maximum reimbursable amount.
