<b>INSTRUCTIONS:</b> With the Implementation of the "Groundwater and Freshwater Protection Act" on November 22, 1993, registration of pesticides in Michigan now requires submission of both a registration fee and a groundwater protection fee for <u>each</u> product registered. The groundwater protection fee is based upon a designation of the pesticide as either "specialty" or "non-specialty."  A specialty pesticide means a disinfectant, sanitizer, germicide or biocide. It also includes pesticides labeled <i>solely</i> for use in areas associated with the household or home life including garden and ornamental uses or on institutional or industrial premises. Specialty pesticides do not include those labeled for use on rights-of-way or other outdoor wide-area treatments. Any pesticide which does not fit the description of a specialty pesticide is considered a non-specialty pesticide.  <b>The <u>annual</u> fee schedule is as follows:</b>  <b>Registration Fee:</b> \$40 per product (all products) <b>Groundwater Protection Fee:</b> Specialty Products- \$100 per product  Non-Specialty Products- 0.75% of the wholesale value of the product sales for use in the state of Michigan. A <b>\$150 minimum fee is due at the time of registration</b> with the balance (if applicable) due before October 1 of the next registration year. (The Michigan registration year is July 1-June 30.) Registrants will receive a listing of their products which have been designated as "non-specialty" approximately one month prior to the October 1 <sup>st</sup> due date.  <b>To complete registration, submit one copy of this form, one copy of each product label, one copy of EPA form 8570-5 "Notice of Supplemental Registration " for each product, if applicable, and a check made payable to "STATE OF MICHIGAN" to the address printed on the top of this form.</b>
