Local MCH Services

DESCRIPTION

Beginning in FY '98 the previous Maternal, Infant and Children's funding was combined with local MCH services in a Maternal and Child Health(MCH) block grant for local agencies to allow them to address the particular needs of women, infants and children in their jurisdiction based on a needs assessment. Consequently these funds are reported in a variety of programs such as child health, immunizations, etc.

As described above local MCH is used as a funding source for local health departments to address the local needs of women, infants and children. Prenatal Care Outreach and Service Delivery Support

DESCRIPTION

Prenatal care outreach and support services include three components:

1. Prenatal care outreach and advocacy services provided at the grassroots level to facilitate access to prenatal care. Services include activities such as media time, hotlines and services to specially targeted populations;
2. Medicaid Outreach and advocacy services, for local health departments changed to Maternal and Child Outreach Enrollment and Coordination in FY 2001, to provide capacity to local health departments and community agencies to locate and assist in the enrollment of women and children in Medicaid programs and services;
3. The Maternal and Infant Health Advocacy Services (MIHAS) program, designed to outreach to high risk pregnant women who are not in care to assist them in handling any barriers to remaining in prenatal care and assure health care for their infants.

FUNDING EXPENDITURES AND ALLOCATIONS

Note that in FY 2000 Medicaid Outreach and Advocacy funding was provided to seven community-based health care providers and three migrant agencies to find and enroll women and children in Medicaid programs. The funding previously provided to local health departments was transferred to the managed care plans, consequently there are no expenditures reported for local health departments. However, in FY 2001 the funding was returned to the local health departments and renamed Maternal and Child Outreach Enrollment and Coordination.

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Family Planning and Pregnancy Prevention

DESCRIPTION

The Pregnancy Prevention services are similar to the services required in the Title X Family Planning Program consequently they are reflected together for simplicity in reporting financial data and program users. These programs make available general reproductive health assessment, comprehensive contraceptive services, related health education and counseling, and referrals as needed. The primary target population is low-income women and men although services are available to anyone.

Funding is provided to 51 delegate agencies which assure availability statewide. More than 86% of the funds appropriated for family planning local agreements and the pregnancy prevention program are distributed for the direct provision of services.
