

Bus Inspection Report to the Michigan Legislature for School Year 2001-2002

This report is published in accordance with Section 1401(1) of Act 526 of the Public Acts of 2002, the appropriations authorization for the Department of State Police. Section 1401(1) mandates a report be submitted to the House and Senate Appropriations Subcommittees on State Police and the House and Senate Fiscal Agencies by March 1, 2003, regarding inspections conducted for the calendar year 2002.

The Motor Carrier Division of the Michigan State Police conducts the annual inspection requirements in accordance with the school year calendar, which is September 1st to August 31st. Therefore, the Division is publishing this report for the school year of September 1, 2001 to August 31, 2002.

Definitions:

- Passed Inspection means the bus was found to have no defects the first time it was inspected during that school year.
- Red-Tagged means a bus that was found to have a defect that prevented the bus from being used to transport pupils to and from school and school-related events until repairs were made.
- Yellow-Tagged means a bus that was found to have a defect that required repairs to be made within 60 days, but still could be used to transport pupils to and from school and school-related events.
