YOE 2007 - Gaylord North Comp Review Notes
Tuscarora Township Hall
June 22, 2005

Comp 103 (Don Stacks)

- Stand 15 – Change to thinning.

Comp 123 (Don Stacks)

- Stand 2 – Add comment: Slashed burned in stand west of Red School Rd in 1992.
- Stand 6 – Add comment: Consider final harvest in ten years along with stand 7.
- Stand 7 - Add comment: Consider final harvest in ten years along with stand 6.
- Stand 25 – Add comment: Buffer seeps when preparing sale. Use aspen for snags.

Comp 134 (Don Stacks)

- Stand 20 – Add comment: Mark 4 - 8 aspen per acre for coarse wood debris.
- Comp header – Add comment: Change to say multi-use recreational rail trail, instead of snowmobile, runs through the comp.
- Map – Add hiking symbol to the multi-use recreation trail.
- Stand 25 – Add comment: Remember to re-berm road as sale is closed.

Comp 135 (Dan Heckman)

- Stand 48 – Add comment: Mark 4 - 8 trees per acre of same proportional mix of stand for coarse wood debris.
- Stands 26, 41 – Add comment: Try to encourage cedar regeneration and leave average 2 – 3 cedar logs per acre for hemlock nursery logs.
- Comp header – Add comment: Specific recreation opportunities include dispersed camping and multi-use recreational rail trails.
- Comp header – Add comment: Approved closing county-owned trail road along west side of lake south of the section line.

Comp 143 (Don Foco)

- Stands 415, 419 – Prescribe opening maintenance using prescribed burn.
- Stands 32, 34 – Add comment to put two yew enclosures in the stand. Put in IFMAP as soon as possible.
- Stand 17 – Site Index missing. Limiting factor cited. This M3 stand probably doesn't meet silvicultural criteria.

Comp 163 (Shannon Harig)

- Stands 64, 66, 67 – Remove harvest prescription. Age missing. Comment: Natural stand, leave for biodiversity value.
- Stand 56 – Include small portion of the stand in adjacent compartment to the west.
- Stand 7 – Prescribe for final harvest and factor limit for access.
- Stand 404 – Coded as X, should it be G?

Comp 169 (Shannon Harig)

- Stand 48 – Separate out 30 acres for final harvest. Add comment: Leave a total of 20 BA of a mix of white oak, red pine and white pine.
- Stand 25 – Prescribe final harvest with aspen objective. Code partial cut. Add comment: Leave any oak. Mark 4 – 8 trees per acre for coarse woody debris.
- Comp comment: MCCC trail runs across the north edge of the compartment.
- Stand 13 – Add comment: Check LOTS regarding status of I-75 and whether it is a stand.

Comp 180 (Ken Phillips)

- Stand 1 – Split out and form new stand from the portion west of the drainage, no prescription for harvest and factor limit. Add comment: Mark 4 – 8 trees per acre and fell for coarse woody debris.
- Stand 22 – Add locked comment: Biologist heard red shouldered hawk in the vicinity.
- Stand 20 – Add comment: Block branches off road that leads to the private parcel; allow road to the private parcel to remain open.
- Comp header – Remove any mention of the east route of the snowmobile trail.

Comp 210 (Dan Heckman)

- Stand 33 – Prescribe final harvest. Add comment: Plant mixture of red and white pine and oak.
- Stand 63 – Final harvest. Code partial cut. Add comment: Harvest all the aspen and red pine except leave one red pine per acre. Leave all white pine. Keep sale boundary south of the old railroad grade.
- Stand 31 – Remove prescription.
- Stand 7 – Add cultural need.

Comp 219 (Ken Phillips)
