WATERWAYS MAPS

Two beautifully designed maps at Rivard Plaza highlight the importance of the Detroit River within the international waterways. An inlaid granite map highlights the 32-mile long Detroit River and its surrounding communities, and a standing sculptured glass map shows the entire St. Lawrence Seaway route.



CULLEN FAMILY CAROUSEL

The carousel, located at Rivard Plaza, was handcrafted and specially designed for Detroit. It features creatures native to the Detroit River, along with the mythical River Mermaid and River Monster.

MILLIKEN STATE PARK AND HARBOR

As the first urban state park in Michigan, the William G. Milliken State Park and Harbor features a renovated 52-slip harbor, a 63-foot replica of the Tawas Point lighthouse, covered picnic areas, fishing outlooks, wildlife observation trails, interpretive signage, storm water treatment demonstration and a memorial to Detroit River advocate and philanthropist, Peter Stroh. BUTTERFLY GARDENS AND LABYRINTH

At Gabriel Richard Park, visitors can stroll along paths through flower gardens that attract butterflies or take a winding tour of an inlaid brick labyrinth.

FISHING OUTLOOKS

The Detroit Riverfront is known for its great fishing and offers locations for those wanting to cast a line out in the water, including William G. Milliken State Park and Harbor and Mt. Elliott Park.

DEQUINDRE CUT GREENWAY

This 1.35-mile urban greenway provides a link between the Riverfront and historic Eastern Market, offering a new way for pedestrians and cyclists to access two Detroit landmarks and the neighborhoods in between.
