

## INVITATION TO BID

The Chippewa County Economic Development Corporation will receive sealed bids for the Runway 16/34 Concrete Repairs project at the Mead & Hunt Lansing office, Lansing, Michigan, until 10:00 am (local time) Friday, August 3, 2012. Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately following the time stated above.

All bidders must be MDOT pre-qualified. There is zero (0) percent DBE requirement for this project.

Bids shall be addressed to Mead & Hunt, Inc., 2605 Port Lansing Road, Lansing, MI 48906. Bids shall be sealed and shall have the name and address of the bidder clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. The envelope shall also be marked with the following: **CIU Runway 16/34 Concrete Repairs Project**. Bids must be submitted on the bid forms (provided in the proposal).

Bidders will submit a proposal guaranty in the form of a proposal bond, certified check, cashier's check or bank money order in the amount of not less than five (5) percent. The proposal guaranty will be made payable to Chippewa County Economic Development Corporation. If the selected contractor fails to provide the required materials and/or execute the contract within twenty-eight (28) days after being furnished with the necessary contract and bond forms, the proposal guaranty will be forfeited to the Sponsor (in accordance with Section 30-07 of the General Provisions). The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory 100 percent performance bond as well as labor and material bond.

No bid may be withdrawn after closing time for the receipt of proposals for a period of ninety (90) calendar days.

The Chippewa County Economic Development Corporation, reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the bids or bid, should it consider same to be in its best interest.

This project is being funded in part with Federal Aviation Administration and Michigan Department of Transportation funding. All bidders are required to sign a certification that they will comply with all Federal and State non-discrimination laws and regulations. Work under this project is subject to the most recent Federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determination. All state and federal guidelines must be followed.

### **Scope of Work**

The project will consist of the removal and replacement of concrete pavement on Runway 16/34.
