

Harry W. Browne Airport New Terminal Building

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Saginaw County H.W. Browne Airport will receive sealed bids for a new terminal building on Friday, April 20, 2012 at the H.W. Browne Airport until 2:00 PM (local time). Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the time stated above.

MDOT prequalification is not required on this project. The contractor completing the terminal building must show experience in this type of work. Work experience must be at least three similar commercial projects within the last five years with the same or greater scope. This information shall be included in the bid submittal.

This project has a 5% requirement for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE). Additional information regarding DBE requirements can be found in the MDOT Requirements section Requirements for DBE/WBE or by contacting SimsR@michigan.gov. If a contractor cannot meet the 5% goal, a Good Faith Effort (GFE) form will need to be completed and submitted documenting efforts made to include DBEs.

Bids shall be addressed to the H. W. Browne Airport, 4821 Janes Road, Saginaw, MI 48601. Bids must be sealed and shall have the name and address of the bidder clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. The envelope shall also be marked with the following: **Terminal Building, Saginaw County H.W. Browne Airport**. Bids must be submitted on the bid forms (provided in the proposal).

Bidders will submit a proposal guaranty in the form of a proposal bond, certified check, cashier's check or bank money order in the amount of 5% of bid amount. The proposal guaranty will be made payable to Saginaw County. If the selected contractor fails to provide the required materials and/or execute the contract within twenty-eight (28) days after being furnished with the necessary contract and bond forms, the proposal guaranty will be forfeited to the Sponsor (in accordance with Section 30-07 of the General Provisions).

No bid may be withdrawn after closing time from the receipt of proposals for a period of forty five (45) calendar days. The Saginaw County H.W. Browne Airport reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the bids or bid, should it consider same to be in its best interest.

This project is being funded in part with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) funding. All state and federal guidelines must be followed.

SCOPE OF WORK

The project involves the construction of a new 3,100 SF terminal building and related sitework.

The project shall be complete and ready for final inspection within one hundred sixty (160) days from the effective date of Notice-to-Proceed.

A Pre-Bid meeting will be held at the Saginaw County H.W. Browne Airport, Terminal Building Conference Room, on Tuesday, April 10, 2012, at 2:00 PM local time. General Contractor attendance is mandatory. Mechanical Contractor attendance is highly recommended.
