

This AGREEMENT made in duplicate as of the 10th day of August, A.D. 1954.

BETWEEN:

LAKEHEAD PIPE LINE COMPANY, INC., a
Company having its principal office
in the City of Wilmington, in the
State of Delaware, one of the United
States of America (hereinafter called
the "COMPANY"),

OF THE FIRST PART,

- and -

HARCO CORPORATION, a Company having
its head office in the City of Cleveland,
in the State of Ohio, one of the United
States of America (hereinafter called
the "CONTRACTOR"),

OF THE SECOND PART.

WHEREAS the COMPANY owns and operates a pipe line system
for the transportation of crude oil;

AND WHEREAS a part of the said pipe line system extends
from the COMPANY'S Pump Station at Superior, Wisconsin, to the West bank
of the St. Clair River in the City of Marysville, Michigan, which part
of the said pipe line system is hereinafter referred to as the "pipe
line";

WITNESSETH that in consideration of the covenants,
provisoes and agreements hereinafter contained to be performed by the
parties hereto and the payments hereafter to be made, IT IS MUTUALLY
AGREED as follows:

1. The CONTRACTOR will carry out a survey over the route
of the said pipe line to determine optimum Base Bed sites and load
requirements and such other information as is necessary to enable a
