

such liability insurance does not cover bodily injury or death or damage to property of others.

20. The CONTRACTOR shall carry in an Insurance Company or Companies acceptable to and approved by the COMPANY, at his own expense and cost, the following insurance with limits not less than shown on the respective items:

(1) Workmen's Compensation insurance to the limit required by the laws of the State or States in which work is being done.

(2) Employer's Liability Insurance.

Bodily Injury - Limit \$100,000/200,000.

(3) Comprehensive General Liability including Contractor's Protective Liability Insurance.

Bodily Injury - Limit \$100,000/200,000

Property Damage - Limit \$100,000

(4) Automobile Liability (owned, non-owned or hired units)

Bodily Injury - Limit \$100,000/200,000

Property Damage - Limit \$100,000.

All such liability policies shall be written in such terms that the CONTRACTOR is fully covered thereunder notwithstanding his assumption of liability and his indemnity covenants contained in this Agreement.

Prior to commencement of any work hereunder the CONTRACTOR shall provide the COMPANY with a Certificate of Insurance satisfactory to the COMPANY establishing that the above requirements have been complied with, and further establishing that the Insurance Company or Companies which have issued the required policies have all
