       Pursuant to 18 USC 922(g)(8), the Court found, at a hearing, that the Defendant represents a credible threat to the physical safety of one or more persons as defined in 18 USC 922(g)(8) and 18 USC 921(b)(2) and named in term #16.

IT IS SO ORDERED that the Defendant be placed on probation under the supervision of the above named probation officer for the term indicated, and the Defendant shall:

- 1. Not violate any criminal law of any unit of government.
- 2. Not leave the state without the consent of this court.
- 3. Make a truthful report to the probation officer monthly, or as often as the probation officer may require, either in person or in writing, as required by the probation office the [ 1<sup>ST</sup> ] [TUESDAY] of every month from 8:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. or 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. at the 65-A District Court Probation Department in St. Johns, MI.
- 4. Notify the probation officer immediately of any change of address or employment status.
- 5. Not purchase or possess a firearm.

6. Pay the following: F&C = 1.\$1475.00 2.\$490.00 \*RESTITUTION \$84.00 Prosecution Costs \$270.00

TOTAL DUE: \$2319.00

FINE & COSTS amount due shall be paid AT: FORTHWITH and paid in full by the due date on the judgment of sentence unless otherwise ordered. Fines, costs, and fees not paid within 66 days of the date owed are subject to a 20% late penalty on the amount owed. If a cash bond/bail was personally posted by the Defendant, payment toward the total is to first be collected out of that bond/bail and allocated as specified under MCL 775.22.

- 7. Shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverage and shall not enter establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold or served as a primary business. Shall submit to random screenings.
- 8. Shall not use, sell, dispense, deliver or possess any controlled substance/non-prescription drugs, nor be in the presence of any person who is involved in such activity. Shall submit to random screenings.
- 9. Shall participate in and successfully complete such courses of instruction, group therapy or individual counseling as directed by the probation officer and pay all costs involved in the programs.
- 10. Shall attend AA/NA \_\_\_\_\_ times per week with written verification of attendance.
- 11. Shall attend the Victim's Impact Panel.
- 12. Shall surrender his/her driver's license for a period of \_\_\_\_\_.
- 13. Shall not drive in violation of restricted/suspended/revoked operator's license.
- 14. Shall spend 15 DAYS of the probation in the Clinton County Jail, with DAYS suspended upon probation review, credit for ANY (time served in inpatient treatment) day(s) served.
- 15. Shall not have any assaultive, or threatening, or harassing, or intimidating behavior towards anyone.
- 16. Shall have no contact with the victim(s) in this matter.

17. Probation shall be monitored through the 65-A District Court located @ 100 E. State Street, Suite 3300, St. Johns, MI (989) 224-5157. Shall participate and adhere to all requirements of the Lawyers and Judges Assistance Program-State Bar of Michigan. Shall be required to wear a SCRAM tether anklet for the detection of alcoholic beverages in defendant's system.


