**CONSENT FINAL ORDER**

This matter having come before the Court on a Complaint and Order to Show Cause why an Order should not be entered appropriating and applying Defendant Tena Lounsberry's assets to reimburse the State for the cost of his confinement in a State correctional facility in accordance with the *State Correctional Facility Reimbursement Act* ("SCFRA"), being MCL 800.401, *et seq.*, and the parties having consented to this Order as evidenced by the signature of

counsel and by Defendant Tena Lounsberry appearing below and the Court being otherwise fully advised:

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

1. The Defendant Tena Lounsberry is incarcerated in a State of Michigan correctional facility.

2. Defendant Tena Lounsberry's current cost of incarceration through her maximum release date is \$376,590.00; Defendant Tena Lounsberry's earliest released date has passed.

3. In order to avoid the cost of further litigation, including the potential costs associated with the appellate process, the parties have agreed to resolve this matter according to the terms of this Order.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

The funds held in Defendant Tena Lounsberry's prison account (excluding wages) shall be disbursed as follows:

a. 60% percent to the "State of Michigan," and electronically mailed to Julius O. Curling Assistant Attorney General, Department of Attorney General, Prison Reimbursement Section.


b. The remaining 40% percent to Defendant Tena Lounsberry.

4. Upon entry of this order all receiverships or freezes on Defendant Tena Lounsberry's prison account as established by previous Order of this Court in this matter shall be terminated except as described above.

5. Upon the above disbursements this case shall be dismissed without cost and without prejudice to any party.

6. This Order resolves the last pending claim and closes the case.
