

Yahoo! Safe Search Filter

To change the settings on a Yahoo! Search engine, simply go to your Yahoo! Homepage, so type in www.yahoo.com. Once you do this, it will open the typical window. Leave the search field blank, but click to the right of that on “Web Search.” This will pull up a new screen that gives you some options. Toward the bottom, choose “Search Preferences.”

Once you click that, this screen will pop up and then you will see the first option is “Safe Search” – click “edit” which is to the right of that. The default will be the middle option. What you want to do is click right above that, to filter out additional web pages with adult content. Click on the “Save” button, click on “Finished” and you are right back where you started only you have a more strict approach to surfing on the Internet.

In the reverse, if you would like to change the settings back, choose search preferences again, choose edit, then determine whether you want to return to the default setting or the even lesser standard below that. Once you do this, please notice that after you click “Save” it asks that you are 18 and provides a disclaimer that you must accept acknowledging that you may see adult content as a result of this change. Click “Accept” and “Finished” and now your search engine will allow other materials to come through.
