DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Soil Erosion Control Measures Installation in the outlet channel of the Shiawassee Flats Dam near the junction of the Shiawassee River and the Bad River. The Soil Erosion Control Measures include: install temporary silt fence and turbidity curtain, replace radial gate bottom seals, install new inlet/outlet staff gauges, strip and stockpile bank topsoil, place permanent steel sheet piling along the discharge edge of the 'spillway' to form a new scour cutoff wall, place temporary steel sheet piling to form a temporary cofferdam, pressure grout fill the voids under the 'spillway', excavate and re-grade the channel banks to accept riprap, transport spoils to designated upland stockpile site, provide and place 2 ft. minimum thickness of heavy riprap on 6" of filter stone on heavy geotextile fabric, fill the outlet channel scour hole with 2 ft. minimum thickness of heavy riprap over plain riprap bulk fill, replace stockpiled topsoil, apply temporary seed, mulch and mulch blanket, all as indicated in the Project Plans and Specifications. In order to coordinate the Spillway Voids Grout Filling work with DNRE's radial gates closure schedule, sheet piling must be set in place by September 8, 2010. If this schedule cannot be met, due to no fault of the CONTRACTOR, Spillway Voids Grout Filling work may be delayed until Spring 2011.

Bid Security and Performance Bonds: Required Not Required
