Successful bidder will be required to furnish Performance, Labor and Material Bonds covering the entire work as specified in the General Conditions.

Bangor Township Schools reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities and/or informalities and to make an award in any manner deemed in the best interest of the Owner. Proposals shall be made on the forms provided as part of the Bidding Documents. After the time of opening, no bid may be withdrawn for a period of 30 days.
