DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Installation of an Infantry Squad Battle Course (ISBC) with five objectives for live fire training of Infantry Squads at the existing small arms facility of the Department of Veterans and Military Affairs Camp Grayling Annual Training Site, Grayling, Michigan. Range includes automated target systems (ATS) arranged in 5 course objectives controlled and scored by computer. Work on the range will include modifying existing topography as necessary for target placement, installation of concrete and timber target coffins, concrete and timber objective structures and service road installation. Support facilities: combined operations building containing male / female latrines, general instruction room, administrative room, and storage area; an ammo breakdown building; mess shelter; bleacher enclosure, control tower; and utilities as required.

Bid Security and Performance Bonds: Required Not Required

All Bidders submitting bids in excess of \$100,000.00 must be certified by the Department of Civil Rights for compliance with State of Michigan Equal Employment Opportunity requirements prior to submission of bids. **Note:** Due to recent processing improvements by the Department of Management & Budget (DMB) and the Department of Civil Rights (DCR) concerning Certificates of Awardability, consideration may be given to bids received while final certification is still pending. Notice shall indicate the contract bid upon, the scheduled bid opening date, the name and phone number(s) of a contact person able to speak for the bidder on the subject of awardability, and the date on which the bidder's application for Certificate of Awardability was initially filed.
- Ensure that all information required on the application for Certificate of Awardability was provided to MDCR.
