DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The project scope, subject to availability of Federal Funds, involves the construction of a building complex consisting of four buildings, and comprising a total of 8,790 square feet, covering a total of 7.5 acres of property. The project is sited on a vacant parcel on Murphy Road near Range 4 at Camp Grayling. Building types for three buildings are one story, masonry construction, wood truss, asphalt shingles, aluminum frame thermal windows, hollow metal doors, gypsum board and metal stud interior walls, and durable finishes through-out. The fourth building type will be a pre-engineered metal building, with ballistic resistant interior wall and ceiling construction. Construction will include all grading, drainage, new drive and new parking lot.

The complex of buildings will be comprised of the following:

- 1 – Live Fire Shoot House – 4,331 sq.ft.
- 1 – Combined Building – 3,539 sq.ft.
- 1 – Ammo Breakdown Building – 120 sq.ft.
- 1 – Covered Mess Shelter – 800 sq.ft.

Bid Security and Performance Bonds: Required Not Required

All Bidders submitting bids in excess of \$100,000.00 must be certified by the Department of Civil Rights for compliance with State of Michigan Equal Employment Opportunity requirements prior to submission of bids. **Note:** Due to recent processing improvements by the Department of Management & Budget (DMB) and the Department of Civil Rights (DCR) concerning Certificates of Awardability, consideration may be given to bids received while final certification is still pending. - Ensure that all information required on the application for Certificate of Awardability was provided to MDCR.
