## DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The project scope, subject to the availability of Federal Funds, involves the construction of a building complex comprising a total of 145,399 square feet which is sited on a vacant parcel within Area 600 at Camp Grayling. All building types are one and two story masonry cavity-wall construction, wood truss, architectural grade asphalt shingles, aluminum frame thermal windows /doors and durable finishes through-out. Construction will include all grading, drainage, utility extensions, new roadway and parking. The complex of buildings will comprise of;

- 5 - Enlisted Men's Barracks (the fifth is an alternate) -16,580 sq. ft. each.
- 1- DFAC (Mess Hall) 10,465 sq. ft.
- 1- Bachelor Officers Quarters – 22,912 sq. ft.
- 1- Company Operations Facility – 18,530 sq. ft.
- 1- Battalion Headquarters – 10,592 sq. ft.
