## DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Range Urban Assault Course-

Construct a (5) Station Range (Combination of Live Fire and Non-Live Fire) for training soldiers in an urban environment. Also construct Range Support Buildings as noted below.

Station 1-838 sft 1-story building consisting of wood posts and exterior plywood walls, no roof.

Station 2-1052 sft 2-story building consisting of wood posts and exterior plywood walls.

Station 3-Construct target emplacements and a wood building façade.

Station 4-1536 sft 3-story concrete block building

Station 5-Underground Trainer with approximately 470 lft of 36" & 48" dia. RCP storm sewer, precast concrete storm sewer manholes and concrete headwall.

Combined Building-2,846 sft 1-story concrete block building with classroom, office and latrine areas.

Mess Shelter-741 sft pavilion

Bleacher Enclosure-567 sft 1-story concrete block building

Ammo Breakdown Building-120 sft 1-story concrete block building

Control Tower-277 sft steel column tower (15' tall)

The (5) Station Range and Range Support Buildings will include miscellaneous appurtenances, including but not limited to, mechanical equipment, electrical equipment, aggregate parking areas, a potable water well, an on-site septic tank with drainfield and restoration.

- Ensure that all information required on the application for Certificate of Awardability was provided to MDCR.
